One Direction finished third in the competition, but they were quickly signed to a record deal with Cowell's record label, Syco Music.

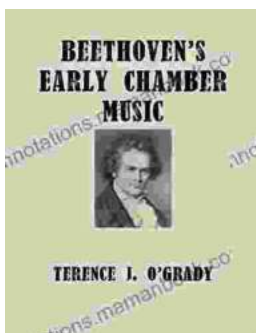
